BAKING INSTRUCTIONS: Preheat oven to 375 F. Place calzones on parchment lined sheet pan and bake for 10 to 12 minutes. For even baking, turn the sheet pan around after 6 minutes of bake time. Remove the cal₂₀₁es from the oven after baking and brush each cal₂₀₁es with the seasoned oil mixture. Oven temperatures and cook times may vary. Calzones are baked when the internal temperature reaches 165 degrees F and the crust is golden brown.
