PRODUCT: Ultra Loco Bread with Wrappers

PACK SIZE: 12/12 ct

SIMPLE DESCRIPTION: 6" Round Whole Grain Premium Style Gordita Bread with printed wrappers included in the case.

ENHANCED DESCRIPTION: Each individual portion of Ultra Loco Bread should present grill marks on the bottom, with bubbled browning spots on top. Ultra Loco Bread is a whole grain rich product. When heated each piece should be soft and supple for ease of handling. Each 1.96 oz portion contains 3 grams fiber, and provides 2 grains/breads for the NSLP. Case to include 144 preprinted, quilted paper wrappers.

INGREDIENTS: Whole white wheat flour, enriched wheat flour (wheat flour, malted barley flour, niacin, reduced iron, thiamine mononitrate, riboflavin and folic acid), water, vegetable oil, oatfiber, yeast, sugar, salt, fermented wheat, calcium propionate, mono & di-glycerides, guar gum, potassium chloride, enzymes.

ALLERGENS: Wheat, Soy

SHELF LIFE: 12 months frozen. 21 days refrigerated at 40°. 5 days on dry shelf with package sealed.

HEATING INSTRUCTIONS: Ultra Loco Bread is fully baked but performs best if slightly warmed

- For best results thaw out to room temperature prior to heating
- Place in warming box (leave in bag) 1 hour thawed or 2 hours frozen
- For individual pieces (out of bag) microwave for 15 seconds thawed or 30 seconds frozen
