

“Buy American” Compliance Statement

Section 104(d) of the William F. Goodling Child Nutrition Reauthorization Act of 1998 requires schools and institutions participating in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) in the contiguous United States to purchase, to the maximum extent practicable, domestic commodities or products for use in meals served under the NSLP and SBP.

The legislation defines “domestic commodity or product” as one that is produced in the United States and is processed in the United States substantially using agricultural commodities that are produced in the United States. The report accompanying the legislation stipulated that “substantially” means that over 51 percent of the final processed product consists of agricultural commodities that were grown domestically.

The J.R. Simplot Company certifies that the below food products were manufactured in the United States and have at least 51% U.S. contents. The products listed below comply with the Buy American Act.
